Subscription Years are for 12 calendar months with annual renewal on the anniversary of your joining date. Your full membership fee is due for payment upon application and payment by monthly instalments is also available. This requires payment of 30% of the membership fee upon application followed by a standing order for 7 monthly instalments of 10% of the membership fee. *Note: Payment by instalments requires a commitment to pay the full subscription – it is not a monthly membership scheme.*

Competition Golf

Entry into club competitions (excluding SOGO) require a current Handicap Index (HI). Please check individual competition rules in the current Club Handbook for specific HI restrictions and eligibility.

Membership Categories

- **Full Members** may play any day of the week and at weekends and may enter any competition for which they are eligible.
 - **Weekday Members** may play Mondays to Fridays and may enter any weekday competition for which they are eligible plus designated weekend 'social' competitions.^
 - **Intermediate Members (Age 18 – 35 on the date they join the club)** may play any day of the week and at weekends and may enter any competition for which they are eligible.
 - **Associate Members** may play any day of the week except Saturday but may not play in any club competitions except designated weekend 'social' competitions^ (current HI required) and SOGO (no HI required).
 - **Juniors** may play any day of the week and may enter any Junior competitions for which they are eligible. Juniors with a sufficiently low HI may also enter some adult competitions. There are 3 Junior membership categories as follows:
 - **Juniors Under 12** (under 12 years of age on 1st January of joining/renewal year) must be accompanied on the course by a responsible adult. Where a group of Juniors wish to play and one of them is under 12 then this may be allowed with specific permission of the Club Pro.
 - **Juniors 12-14** (12 years of age or over and under 15 years of age on 1st January of current year)
 - **Juniors 15-18** (15 years of age or over and under 18 years of age on 1st January of current year)
 - **Country Members** must have a "home" address which is at least 30 miles from the club. They may play any day of the week apart from Saturday morning. Country members may not play in any club competitions except designated weekend 'social' competitions^ (current HI required) and SOGO (no HI required).
 - **Off Peak Members** may play 7 days per week before 7.30am and after 3pm in summer and before 8:30am and after 2pm in the winter months.
 - **Introductory/'Get Into Golf'** We have a number of introductory packages aimed at both people new to golf and experienced golfers returning to golf. Please see website for current details.
- ^ Designated weekend 'social' competitions are Captains' Charity Day, Bracken Ghyll Memorial Cup and the Grand Draw Competition.

- **Able to hold office and be a Director of the Club**
All adult members except Introductory and Country Members
- **Membership of the English Golf Union**
All members except Introductory Members and Juniors Under 12.
